Citi Volunteers in Hong Kong Celebrate the Tenth Annual Global Community Day

**Over 3,300 volunteers will join 5 NGOs in 23 community activities to make a

HONG KONG – Citi announces its celebration of the 10th annual Global Community Day (GCD) on Saturday, June 13 to demonstrate its ongoing and long-standing commitment in the local community.

Over 3,300 Citi Hong Kong employees, along with their families, friends and corporate clients, will engage in 23 community activities for 5 NGO partners with the common goal to give back to the community in which they work and live.

Speaking at the kick off ceremony, Lawrence Lam, Head of Sales and Distribution, Citibank Global Consumer Banking and Chairman of Citi Community Club said, “Global Community Day is an annual tradition here at Citi, demonstrating our long-term commitment to corporate citizenship. In the past nine years, we have mobilized over 54,000 volunteers globally through this annual event to reach out to the needy in the communities of over 400 cities spanning 90 countries. This year, over 3,300 volunteers in Hong Kong will participate in a wide range of volunteering, fundraising and community giving activities including doing renovation work for elderly hostels; spending time with underprivileged children in arts & crafts games, bus tour and tour in the Peak; as well as caring for the elderly and the mentally- and physically-challenged around Hong Kong. We have also arranged programs promoting environmental awareness,”

Mr. Lam continued, “Volunteerism is a core component of Citi's culture and is a simple and effective way for us to give back to the communities in which we work and live. I firmly believe that through our year-round community services, we can work collectively to strengthening our local community and making a positive contribution to it.”
